#### BY THE GLASS

**Grechetto** Arnaldo-Caprai Grecante // Montefalco // 2021

**6oz 25**

Exotic fruits, yellow peaches, white flowers, pleasant chalkiness on the finish.

Montefalco winemakers used to give 'Grecante' as a gift to local princes and clergymen.

**Nebbiolo** Aldo Conterno 'Il Favot' // Langhe // 2020

**6oz 35**

Dried cherry, plum, dark chocolate, baking spices. 'Il Favot,' or 'the favorite,' is the Conternos' young-vine Nebbiolo. It's one of our favorites, too!

**Sangiovese** Felsina Chianti Classico Riserva 'Rancia' // Chianti Classico // 2019

**6oz 40**

Stewed cherries, balsamic, leather, medium-bodied. This single-vineyard Chianti Classico is traditional and impressive.

#### BY THE BOTTLE

**Chardonnay** Billecart-Salmon Grand Cru Blanc de Blancs // Champagne, France // nv

**BTL 160**

White and yellow fruit, hazelnuts, almonds, buttered brioche. This true Champagne holds a spot on our list as the only non-Italian wine, because everyone needs a little Champagne to celebrate the holidays!

**Nebbiolo** Aldo Conterno Barolo 'Bussia' // Barolo // 2019

**BTL 205**

Medium-bodied. Fresh roses, ripe cherries, wild strawberries. Elegance, weight and focus. Aldo's sons now run this estate, and this Barolo is sourced from some of their best vineyard land in Bussia.

## BY THE BOTTLE

**Nebbiolo** Aldo Conterno Barolo 'Cicala' // Barolo // 2019

**BTL 310**

Terroir-driven, jam berries, licorice, violet flowers, dried roses, full-bodied, dense, and opulent.

The Cicala vineyard shows through as pure power and finesse.

**Corvina/Rondinella** Cesari Amarone della Valpolicella 'Il Bosco' // Veneto // 2016

**BTL 160**

Luxurious and decadent, notes of rich chocolate, coffee, stewed blackberry notes, velvety texture. 'Il Bosco' is a top vineyard in Valpolicella, and the Cesari's vinify from some of its finest plots.

**Sangiovese/Cabernet Sauvignon** Marchesi Antinori 'Tignanello' // Tuscany // 2019

**BTL 325**

Bright berry fruit, dried mint, vanilla, chocolate, spice. Since its first vintage in 1980, 'Tig' has been the benchmark for the Super Tuscan category.

**Sangiovese/Cabernet Sauvignon** Ornellaia // Bolgheri // 2020

**BTL 415**

Ripe red fruits, delicate vanilla, pencil lead, oak. Full-bodied with length and intensity. The current release from Olga Fusari and this long-standing house shows impressive mastery of fruit and vine.

**Sangiovese Grosso** Biondi-Santi Rosso // Montalcino // 2019

**BTL 195**

Cherries, blood oranges, violets, balsamic, licorice. Energetic, structured, and complex. This wine, from the founder of Brunello, is an impressive introduction to the Grosso clone with which they specialize.

**Nero D'Avola/Perricone** Tenuta Regaleali 'Rosso del Conte' // Sicily // 2016

**BTL 180**

Full and intense, dried cherries, blackberries, exotic spices, smoke, walnut.

The Regalealis produce this wine (lit. 'Red wine of the Count') as an ode to their founder: Count Giuseppe Tasca d'Almerita.
